In March, our St. Thomas School Parent Community participated in our second annual Parent Survey—our thanks to all in our having <u>100% participation</u> from our St. Thomas families. Below is a summary of our quantitative results for the five classroom questions (averaged across all six homerooms) and those for the seven schoolwide questions. I would like to note that improvements were made in all five classroom categories over our 2019 results, as well as in six of seven of the schoolwide results.

We are grateful for the collaboration which has made this year a success for our students. The School Advisory Board will be meeting to review all our parent comment feedback and planning on how we can engage our families in sharing these results and identifying action steps to continue to grow and improve our St. Thomas School Learning Community.
