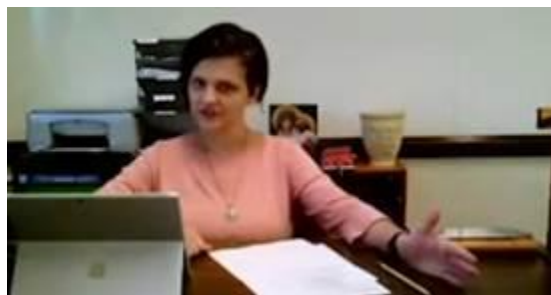

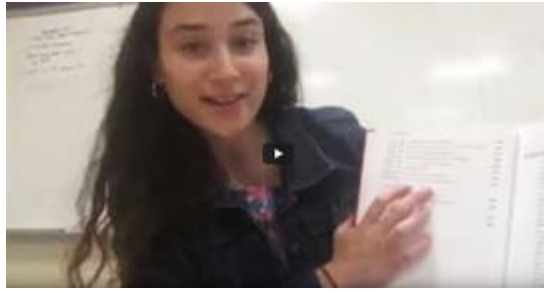

From the Headmaster

School Re-Opening Plan Update—Continued thanks to all for your cooperation as we remain a healthy school community of students, staff and families. Two points for clarification:

- **For Parents at Pick-up:** Given the number of students, staff and parents in the pickup area, we ask that parents who choose to enter into the pick up area wear masks. For parents who remain north of the pick up area, masks are optional. Thank you as we practice these shared precautions at times and in a location of the school campus where we are gathering in larger numbers and social distancing becomes difficult.
- **Should siblings of a student who stays home from school for COVID-like symptoms also remain home?** No, health officials are not recommending siblings of a student who is ill and who do not have symptoms to remain home from school. Siblings are to attend school and be monitored for any appearance of symptoms. Should a student test positive for COVID-19, the county health department will make requests of parents regarding siblings based on a review of the circumstances at home and at school.
