From the Headmaster

Our shared congratulations on the start of our school year which has taken both community-wide collaboration and commitment—together we have provided our students a strong start to the year and given them an opportunity to take their next steps in learning and personal development together. I have personally noticed the change in their demeanor from our first week to our second, from that of quiet concern to a more natural, youthful exuberance. With the guidance and support of our teachers, our students are doing a very good job in implementing our procedures that are contributing to a safe environment for community and learning.

With these precautions in place, I do wish to communicate a clearer symptoms checklist for you as parents and that we will use at school in determining whether a student should remain home, and whether your family doctor should be contacted. Please see the following checklist that provides a clearer understanding of when to respond to a potential COVID infection (provided by the Michigan Chapter of the American Academy Pediatrics.)

SYMPTOMS:

High Risk Symptoms~

- Fever--temperature 100.4 F or higher/chills/body aches
- Cough--new onset or worsening
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Change in ability to taste or smell

If demonstrating any **one or more** high risk symptoms, isolate individual and seek medical evaluation. Notify school.

Lower Risk Symptoms~

- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Fatigue

If yes to **one** of the lower risk symptoms stay at home and monitor for resolution or development of additional symptoms.

If yes to **two or more** of the lower risk symptoms isolate symptomatic individual and seek medical evaluation. Notify school.
