## **Our Lady Poster Project!!!**

Rubrics for the Our Lady poster project (checklist):

**<u>1</u>**. Your project must include **at least two images** of Our Lady on your poster board (one large and one small would work well but you may have several images if you so choose).

<u>2.</u> There must be a **summary** of how Our Lady came to have this title. You should be specific but thorough. You can usually take a summary right off the internet and print it out on an  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$  inch sheet of paper, and attach this to the poster board (*cite your source*).

<u>3.</u> There should be **information on a prominent person**(s) that played a part in how Our Lady came to be known under this title. For example, if you have Our Lady of Guadalupe, then you would have something about St. Juan Diego.

**<u>4.</u>** There should be a **history of devotion** to Our Lady under this title from when it started to the present time.

5. The project must state when the feast day is and any special celebrations that take place on that day. For example, if you had Our Lady of Guadalupe you would state the feast day date (December 12) and what they do to celebrate in Guadalupe, Mexico (pilgrimages, festivals, native dance, mass, etc).
6. Include where this devotion to Our Lady originated (city, state, country).

7. You should also include something about Our Lady under this title that is not very well known.

8. You should be able to fill the entire space of the poster board so that there is not too much "blank space" between the images, texts and any other items that you choose to display. You may have a border of no more than 1 ½ inches but it could be less or you may choose not to have one at all. You should try to make this display as interesting and visually appealing as you can, so that people are drawn to it.
9. The project must have the Our Lady's name/title clearly visible and it should be able to be read

standing at least 10 feet away.

<u>10.</u> The project should have **at least half of the display in color(s);** it can be all in color if you choose. Black and white images and text are fine but make sure that it does not take up too much space. You may choose to use a 22" x 28" poster board of a different color rather than use the white one provided. Maximum poster size is 24" x 36" (fold out).

**<u>11.</u>** The project should display **a prayer** to Our Lady under that title.

**12.** Finally, **Be Creative**. If you want to attach a 3D item (like a religious medal, rosary or something else that adds to explaining the story of your saint), then do it.

13. Last but not least, your name should be on the back of the poster project.

\*Note: Remember that these will be on display for the whole school to see and read. Some of these titles of Our Lady are not known to your viewer, but after seeing your display they should be familiar with it so that they can tell someone else about it. If your viewer is familiar with this devotion to Our Lady, then they should come away knowing something more about it.

**Possible points: 40.** There will be 3 points given for each of the 13 required items above. 4 points will be deducted for each day the project is late.
