St. Thomas 2021-2022 Parent/Student Policy Handbook:

All families should now have a copy of our Parent/Student Handbook along with a signatory page for parent and student signatures. We ask that all families review the policy documents, sign the signatory page and return it to the main office by this **Friday, October 8, 2021**.

COVID Procedures Update:

Last Friday the 2021-2022 Michigan State budget bill took effect which was recently approved by the state legislature and signed by the governor. This bill included provisions preventing mask requirements for those under 18. While the governor expresses the opinion that the mask mandate provisions in the bill are unconstitutional, several county health departments in Michigan have rescinded their mandates, although Washtenaw County has not yet done so. Given that the matter has yet to be adjudicated by the courts, we currently do not have the legal basis needed to enforce children's masking and therefore defer to our students' parents to determine whether their child will wear a mask to school or not. Should the courts provide additional clarity on this matter, we will review with diocesan legal counsel on enforcing the mandate that all students and staff wear a mask. This bill does not impact adult school staff, who will continue to wear a mask unless subject to an exemption under the county order.
