Our Presenter Dr. Mary Healy Dr. Mary Healy is professor of Scripture at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit and a bestselling author and international speaker. She is a general editor of the Catholic Commentary on Sacred Scripture and author of two of its volumes, *The Gospel of Mark* and *Hebrews*. Her other books include *The Spiritual Gifts Handbook* and *Healing*. Dr. Healy serves the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity as a member of the Pentecostal-Catholic International Dialogue. She was appointed by Pope Francis as one of the first three women ever to serve on the Pontifical Biblical Commission.

From the Headmaster

This Friday we invite all our parents to participate in an evening to equip us to effectively guide our children in a time of significant confusion about the truth of the human person and the messages they have/will receive from our surrounding culture. As Pope Francis has said:

Today children—children!—are taught in school that everyone can choose his or her sex. Why are they teaching this? Let us not play with truths. It's true that behind all this we find gender ideology. Let us call things by their names.

COVID-19 Update:

- Please visit our <u>COVID-19 Dashboard</u> on our website to view ongoing public updates.
- The past 2 weeks have seen the following case numbers:
 - November 7 November 13: 6 students—3 resulting in student exposure and quarantines
 - November 14 to Present: 3 students—2 resulting in student exposure and quarantines
 - Note that a child may test positive for COVID-19 and not expose other students based on various circumstances of their not being in school during the 48 hour period before the onset of symptoms when potentially contagious (e.g. school days off, being home due to sibling illness, not scheduled in preschool, etc.)
- Presently there is no evidence of cases involving in-school transmission.
- Should you child display the symptoms following the symptom panel below and you decide to test your child for COVID-19, please provide Mr. DiLaura your test results the same day you test/receive the result—thank you.

Below are symptom profiles, as recommended by the Michigan Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, to determine potential COVID infections. We require a negative result of at least the at-home antigen test (or the lab PCR test) before a child is able to return to school if they have either one high risk symptom or two low risk symptoms. We are all grateful for our parents' collaboration in ensuring the health and safety of the school community.

High Risk Symptoms~

- Fever--temperature 100.4 F or higher/chills/body aches
- Cough--new onset or worsening
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Change in ability to taste or smell

Lower Risk Symptoms~

- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Fatigue

Making Payments to St. Thomas School

Last school year we adopted the e-Funds online payment method to facilitate the payment of lunch orders, athletics fees, fund raising contributions, special event payments, field trip costs, ESP charges, etc. There is a fee charged by the eFunds platform, which, when the payment amount is small, can be a unreasonable percentage of the payment. We therefore recommend that you accumulate charges (not to exceed a month) and note the following fee schedule:

Electronic Funds Transfer from Checking Account: \$1.25 for any amount **Credit Card Charge:** 3%

<u>We are also now again allowing checks</u> to be written out to *St. Thomas School* and turned into the school office for any payments made for school expenses.
