

As beautiful is the Christmas Season itself for our children, Advent is so full of special graces for them as they anticipate all the joy of Christmas. We are calling our students to allow this unique experience of anticipation to influence their actions, helping them receive and mature in the grace of *foresight*—the grace of stopping our hurried, unthought activity to reflect, to plan ahead, to act now in anticipation of something to come—all the graces of this Advent season.

May all of us take special time this Advent to enter into that contemplative reflection of Our Blessed Mother's Immaculate Heart, and allow us to experience the Lord's call on our lives at whatever point we are at on our journey. We have only just begun to experience His love and the consolation, strength and meaning of His favor upon us.

Thank you for your prayers for our Upper School students as they experience the graces of an Advent Retreat on Friday morning, December 10<sup>th</sup> with Dawn Hausmann and Fr. John Whitlock—Diocesan Directors of Women's and Men's Vocations, who will witness and minister to our students, helping them to reflect on God's plan for their life and the meaning of the vocations He calls us to discover our greatest happiness and love within.

We do very much look forward as all the school prepares for this year's Winter Celebration of Wonder, Friday, December 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM. We are grateful for everyone's participation in this very special evening of community and celebration of what our students and teachers are accomplishing.

#### **COVID-19 Update:**

• Per our community wide protocol, **parents are to closely monitor their child's health** and use the symptom profile below to assess the need to test for COVID. Parents are asked to immediately notify Mr. DiLaura of any positive test result.

- Given our current increase in instances of COVID, beginning next week, we will use the following **communication protocol**:
  - Parents of a classroom/grade will be notified of a case in the classroom.
  - COVID cases are personal health information and names of individuals will not be communicated.
  - Any student or staff potentially exposed to a positive COVID case will be notified immediately of the exposure and procedures for quarantine.
  - School wide information will be available on our <u>COVID-19 Dashboard</u>.
- **Quarantine Option for a positive COVID case**: 10 days at home quarantine counting from the first day of symptoms or date of positive test.
- Quarantine Options for an exposure are:
  - Option 1: 10 day at home quarantine without test with no onset of symptoms.
  - Option 2: 7 day at home quarantine with a negative test on day 5 or 6 with no onset of symptoms.
  - Option 3: 14 day in-school quarantine with masking (not available for lunch room, choir or household exposures).
- **Our case timeline** is following that of <u>Washtenaw County region</u> which has had a recent downturn. This peak very closely follows the same case profile for this time last year, with cases peaking the last week of November.
- **Masking** may provide protection from contracting or communicating illness and is generally recommended under current conditions.
