School Policies/Reminders

P.E. Clothes

I mentioned in July that the 6th-8th graders will once more be required to wear gym clothes for P.E. class. These are purchased by the school and given to the students during their first day of P.E. class. **The fee for gym clothes is \$24**, which is due by Friday, August 26th.

When Tardy...

On Tuesdays-Fridays, most or all of the school will be in the church by 8:00. If you arrive at 8:00 or later on a day when they have Mass, please escort your child(ren) into the church so they can join their class. Please do not simply drop your child off at the church or at the office. Mrs. Steffy is not interested in running a child-shuttle. As a reminder, doors open at 7:45, children can go to their classroom at 7:50, and the tardy bell rings at 7:55. If some classes will not be attending Mass on certain days, I'll send out a schedule so that you'll know whether your child has Mass on a given day. On Mondays, parents arriving at or past 8:00 may simply bring their child(ren) to the office.

Lunch Ordering

Hot lunch ordering will begin for the month of October (more details to come). Please note that, this year, the school will not place a lunch order for any student whose parent did not submit an accompanying payment with their order. That will cut down on the confusion and headache surrounding outstanding balances.

Drop-Off and Dismissal Reminders

If children are to be dropped off, they may only be dropped off on Elizabeth Street in front of the school entrance. Please note that there will be no crossing guard. For dismissal at 3:25, parents should wait in the parking lot to pick up children, who will be led by their teachers to the playground to be released from there. Children not picked up by 3:30 will be taken to afternoon ESP and parents billed accordingly.
