Parent Orientation Night



Virtue of the Term: Sacrifice

Father Gerald before Mass today reminded the students that the Mass is a ritual sacrifice. He explained that we have nothing that we can offer the Father that will truly be a worthy gift, so He Himself supplies us with the Offering: Jesus Christ, the perfect offering of Love to the Father. This is the motion of the Mass: the offering of the Perfect Sacrifice on the Altar to the Father, and we in turn, by participating in the Sacrifice of Love, becoming filled with His Holy Spirit. There is no assembly this week, but Father's words fit well with what I would have talked about anyway! The practice of the virtue of sacrifice must constantly draw its life and meaning from this Supreme Sacrifice.

School Policies/Reminders

P.E. Clothes

A reminder to parents of 6th-8th graders to pay \$24 for gym clothes. This can be done at the office with cash or check, or on eFunds.

Dress Code Reminders

Please refer to the dress code for policies on shoes, socks, and belts. These three items have been the most frequently violated areas. Boots are not allowed, and shoe height should remain at or below the ankle area. Shoes must be of uniform color – either black or dark-toned, with girls allowed to wear all-white shoes. Socks need to be crew, and thus at or above the ankle bone. Boys need to wear belts. Beginning this week, we will begin calling home for repeat offenders to have proper wear brought to school.

Lunch Ordering

Hot lunch ordering will begin for the month of October (more details to come). Please note that, this year, the school will not place a lunch order for any student whose parent did not submit an accompanying payment with their order. That will cut down on the confusion and headache surrounding outstanding balances.
