From the Headmaster

At morning assembly today, I talked about how, as Christians, we are all soldiers in a spiritual battle. This theme is present right from the beginning of Lent in the Gospel about Jesus and His 40-day fast in the desert. By resisting the temptations of the devil, He was highlighting how we are at war with ourselves (our concupiscence and pride – the "flesh"), the world, and the devil. After reading from St. Paul's description of our warfare (from Ephesians, Chapter 6), I talked about the different ways by which we can open a door to the evil one, such as habits of lying, of disobedience, and of bitterness and unforgiveness. But we have powerful help from heaven! I highlighted the two saints whose feasts are upcoming – St. Patrick, who fought demonic forces in Ireland, and St. Joseph, "Terror of Demons," whose purity and obedience give him great power against the devil. I asked students to pray for God's help and the intercession of St. Patrick and St. Joseph to close those doors to the devil's influence. In the end, Jesus Christ has the victory, and we have a choice to participate in His victory.
